This week, bills are being heard in the Senate that threaten our future generations' right to life and women's right to bring children into the world.

It saddens me that we are living in a society that seems to have forgotten the value of life. Women should be provided the love and resources they need when preparing to become mothers.

SB23-190 attacks pregnancy centers that provide expecting mothers abortion alternatives, such as adoption.

SB23-189 forces large employers to cover the total cost of abortion services.

SB23-188 increasing access to "reproductive health care services" aka abortion measures

Bill Progress

SB23-109: Today the Senate heard a bill that I sponsored to increase the penalty for drug dealers whose poison kills their customers. The bill passed 2nd reading in the State Senate and will be heard for 3rd reading tomorrow.

HB23-1007: PASSED AND SIGNED INTO LAW!

This bill promotes the accessibility of mental health resources for students enrolled in higher education. It was signed into law on March 17.
